Harwich Farmers' Market Policies

The Harwich Farmers' Market is a public market for the primary purpose of connecting and mutually benefiting Massachusetts farmers, communities, and shoppers while promoting and selling products grown and raised by participating farmers.

- The market will be open for the hours of 3:00pm to 6:00pm Thursdays from mid-June to mid-July annually.
- All products sold at this market will be clearly labeled as to what the product is, ingredients used, and where the ingredients are sourced.
- There will be at least two or more farmers/vendors selling every market.
- The market complies with all applicable local, state, and federal laws and regulations.
- Each vendor will have prices for all items clearly labeled along with accepted methods of payments.
- Vendors are required to apply using this application and approval and all necessary permits from the Harwich Board of Health.
- Grievances between customers and vendors should be first addressed politely and professionally directly with the vendor and if a solution can not be found, the issue should be present to the Market Manager who will involve the sponsor for the market (the Harwich Historical Society) or the town as needed.
- Vendors are required to provide proof of insurance when applying to the market.
- The market is insured through the Harwich Historical Society.
